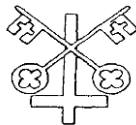

Lower Churchyard Gates

The Parochial Church Council are planning to replace the dilapidated gates to the Lower Churchyard with new oak gates of similar design, to be made by the craftsmen at Harper Adams University. The HA Students Union has generously promised a substantial donation towards the total cost which is expected to be near £3000. We also plan to apply for grants towards the cost.
