

- RECTOR'S FAREWELL** - The farewell services which the Rector will conduct will be on **Sunday September 24<sup>th</sup>**. It is hoped that this will enable as many people as possible, in all parts of the benefice, to say farewell to Edward and Jane. Anyone is most welcome to attend any or all services.

**2 RECTOR'S RETIREMENT DINNER** - A dinner to say farewell to the Rector and Jane and to wish them a happy retirement will take place on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September at 7.00 for 7.30 pm at the Hadley Park House Hotel, Telford.
