

- Today, 11th November is Remembrance Sunday - There will be a service in Church at 10:00am after which we will walk to the War Memorial for the Act of Remembrance at 11:00am. This year we particularly remember the centenary of WW1. There will be contributions from St. Peter's School and 1st Edgmond Scout Group for our worship. All are welcome. The Collection at today's Remembrance Service will be divided between the Royal British Legion and Blind Veterans - formerly known as St Dunstons.

9 **Donations to Telford Food Bank** - Telford Food Bank is managed by a Registered Charity Telford Crisis Support and is based in premises at the Sutton Hill Community Centre. During the year to 31st March 2018 we gave out in excess of 3000 "three-day emergency food parcels" which provided food for approximately 3900 adults and 1650 children and support is continuing at this sort of level this year. This is only possible through the support of the local communities and on behalf of the Trustees and volunteers at the Food Bank I would like to thank those who have given either financial support or donations of food through the box at the back of Edgmond Church.
