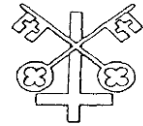

- 3 **At the recent Annual Vestry Meeting**, Mr John Ingram and Mr Chris Taylor were re-elected Churchwardens.

- 4 **The Archdeacon's Visitation** will take place this Wednesday at St Leonard's, Malinslee - 6:30pm for Registration and Documentation followed at 7:30pm by Worship with Archdeacon's Charge. This service is when all Churchwardens in our area will be sworn in following election at their various Annual Vestry Meetings.

- 5 **The next Coffee & Chat morning is this Thursday, 18th May, following the 9:30am Holy Communion service. All welcome.** You do not have to attend the service to be able to have a cup of coffee/tea/squash. Just turn up at the Church at about 10:00am and join us for a cuppa and a chat.



- 6 **Rogation Sunday** is next Sunday, 21st May, and following our tradition at St Peter's, during the 10:30am Communion Service we shall process to the top of the hill (up Rock Lane) for the blessing of the land, crops sown, animals and the village. Everyone is warmly invited to join us for this service.



- 7 **Ascension Day** this year falls on May 25th and following the tradition of St Peter's, Edgmond there will be two celebrations of Holy Communion. The first will be at 7:00am and will be from Common Worship. This service will be followed by hymn singing from the top of the church tower, symbolising Our Lord's return to heaven. The second service will be at 9:30am and will be from the Book of Common Prayer.
