

- Dedication of the New Gates for the Lower Churchyard** - Many of you will be aware that we have a new pair of oak gates for the Lower Churchyard. The gates were created with the full cooperation of Harper Adams University and were crafted in the Estates Department workshops by Edgmond resident Peter Nunn. The PCC received a very generous donation from the Students Union at Harper Adams towards the cost, as well as personal donations from several individuals. The gates will be dedicated by the Rector, in the presence of appropriate representatives from Harper Adams, on **Thursday 18 October at 10:30am**. **Everyone is warmly invited to attend.**
- All Souls Service Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> November 9.30am** - If you would like names of loved ones departed to be read out during this service, please enter the names on the list at the back of the church. **Please note there will be NO service on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> November.**

- 3 **Annual Memorial Service Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> November 6.30pm St. Peter's Church, Edgmond** - This is a time to remember loved ones recently departed. It provides an opportunity to reflect in the presence of God remembering loved ones and offering before God the pain and sorrow that their departing has brought. Names of those departed within the last year will be offered during the service and there will be an opportunity to light a candle in their memory. - 4 **Remembrance Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> November** - There will be a service in Church **at 10:00am** after which we will walk to the War Memorial for the Act of Remembrance at 11:00am. This year we particularly remember the centenary of WW1. There will be contributions from St. Peter's School and 1<sup>st</sup> Edgmond Scout Group for our worship. All are welcome.
- 5 **Operation Christmas Child** - A very big thank you to all who filled Christmas shoe boxes for Operation Christmas Child last year. We are now making the same request again for disadvantaged children around the world. Leaflets with the instructions and suggestions of items to pack are at the rear of the Church. Shoe boxes will be collected from Church at the end of October/beginning of November. I have been asked to stress that the £5 suggested donation towards the shipping cost is purely voluntary. **100 Days of Prayer.** As you will already be aware this year marks the centenary of the end of World War 1 which we will commemorate on Sunday November 11<sup>th</sup>. One hundred days before the end of WW1, on August 4<sup>th</sup>, 1918, George V called the nation and commonwealth to pray for peace. HOPE 2018 have been in conversation with the Queen about a similar initiative, that she calls all people of faith to pray for peace. In response to this HOPE are encouraging us to use the 100 days between August 4<sup>th</sup> and November 11<sup>th</sup> this year to continue to pray for peace and for our nation. We are part way through this now but the Churches in this area have agreed that one Church will have dedicated prayer each day and we have been asked to do this on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> November. There will therefore be a short time of prayer at 9.30am in St. Peter's on this day and all are welcome to attend.
