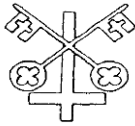

## Lower Churchyard Gates

The go-ahead has now been given for Harper Adams to construct the new oak gates for the Lower Churchyard and the Students Union have raised at least 50% of the anticipated cost of £2500-£3000, a magnificent effort for which we are very grateful. We have also applied for grants towards the cost.
