CORONAVIRUS UPDATED GUIDELINES

The Archbishops of Canterbury and York have updated the guidance to churches which we will be adopting with immediate effect. This means that:-

ALL attending worship are asked to wash their hands when they enter church.

The collection plate will not be passed around. You are invited to leave your offering on the plate as you arrive or as you leave.

Holy Communion will only be offered in one kind. In other words only the wafer will be administered to the congregation. The Priest will receive the wine on behalf of the people.

The Priest will not touch the head of those being blessed.

Handshaking at The Peace will be suspended. We will share The Peace with words and a smile!

The clergy will not shake hands with people as they leave church.

Revd. Helen is mindful that some who are vulnerable may feel they need to restrict mixing with other people. She urges church members to keep in touch by telephone with anyone they know who is staying away or neighbours and friends on their own and she will also be very willing to telephone anyone if they wish.

We are no longer able to offer tea/coffee after the service.
