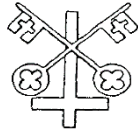

- 5 Come and Worship - Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> March at 4:30pm** in St. Peter's Church. A benefice service of praise and prayer using modern worship songs. Everyone welcome.
- 6 Lent Groups** - There will be two groups across the benefices providing an opportunity for sharing between people from different churches. They will both start the week commencing 11th March and run for five weeks. There will be one taking place on Tuesday afternoons at 2pm (venue to be arranged) and the second Thursday evenings 7.30pm at the home of Penny Westgate in Edgmond. Further details to follow. - 7 Thursday Holy Communion.** This service will now alternate between BCP on 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursdays and Common Worship on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday's. This is so that we have more balance between the forms of liturgy and have opportunity to use Common Worship more widely. The 7.45am Holy Communion on Sunday's will continue to be BCP.
