

- Donations to Telford Food Bank** - Telford Food Bank is managed by a Registered Charity Telford Crisis Support and is based in premises at the Sutton Hill Community Centre. During the year to 31st March 2018 we gave out in excess of 3000 "three-day emergency food parcels" which provided food for approximately 3900 adults and 1650 children and support is continuing at this sort of level this year. This is only possible through the support of the local communities and on behalf of the Trustees and volunteers at the Food Bank I would like to thank those who have given either financial support or donations of food through the box at the back of Edgmond Church. - 3 **All Souls Service Friday 2nd November 9.30am** - If you would like names of loved ones departed to be read out during this service, please enter the names on the list at the back of the church. **Please note there will be NO service on Thursday 1st November.**
- 4 **Annual Memorial Service Sunday 4th November 6.30pm St. Peter's Church, Edgmond** - This is a time to remember loved ones recently departed. It provides an opportunity to reflect in the presence of God remembering loved ones and offering before God the pain and sorrow that their departing has brought. Names of those departed within the last year will be offered during the service and there will be an opportunity to light a candle in their memory. All are welcome to attend this service and Church members are encouraged to attend in support of others. For more information please contact Revd Helen.
- 5 **Remembrance Sunday 11th November** - There will be a service in Church **at 10:00am** after which we will walk to the War Memorial for the Act of Remembrance at 11:00am. This year we particularly remember the centenary of WW1. There will be contributions from St. Peter's School and 1st Edgmond Scout Group for our worship. All are welcome.
- 6 **Operation Christmas Child** - A very big thank you to all who filled Christmas shoe boxes for Operation Christmas Child last year. We are now making the same request again for disadvantaged children around the world. Leaflets with the instructions and suggestions of items to pack are at the rear of the Church. Shoe boxes will be collected from Church at the end of October/beginning of November. I have been asked to stress that the £5 suggested donation towards the shipping cost is purely voluntary. - 7 **Farewell to Revd David Stokes-Harrison** - David has served as Resident Minister in the six parishes since 2007. He will be retiring at the end of November. As we will want to give our thanks to God for David's ministry there will be a joint Benefices service at All Saints Tibberton on Sunday 25th November at 10.30am followed by lunch in Tibberton Village Hall. All are welcome to the service, but the lunch is strictly by ticket only (due to capacity in the hall). Tickets will be available from Revd Helen or Churchwardens and donations towards a gift can also be given to Churchwardens or to Revd Helen.

100 Days of Prayer. As you will already be aware this year marks the centenary of the end of World War 1 which we will commemorate on Sunday November 11th. One hundred days before the end of WW1, on August 4th, 1918, George V called the nation and commonwealth to pray for peace. HOPE 2018 have been in conversation with the Queen about a similar initiative, that she calls all people of faith to pray for peace. In response to this HOPE are encouraging us to use the 100 days between August 4th and November 11th this year to continue to pray for peace and for our nation. We are part way through this now but the Churches in this area have agreed that one Church will have dedicated prayer each day and we have been asked to do this on Tuesday 6th November. There will therefore be a short time of prayer at 9.30am in St. Peter's on this day and all are welcome to attend.
