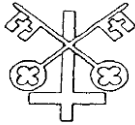

The service ends when we gather outside to Clypp (encircle) the Church while all singing the hymn 'We love the place, O God'. Everyone is most welcome to this ancient celebration for our Patronal Festival of our Parish Church. The service will be followed by light refreshments.

5 **Purple Cope** - The Rector is hoping to purchase a purple cope for use in Advent, Lent and at funerals. A parishioner has already given a donation and if anyone else wishes to give a donation please put it in an envelope clearly marked 'Purple Cope' and hand to either the Churchwardens, Treasurer or Rector. If you can "Gift Aid" your donation, then that will greatly help. (Gift Aid envelopes are available in Church.) The cope will cost about £500.

6 **FOUNDATION GOVERNOR AT ST PETER'S SCHOOL, EDMOND** - Mrs Barbara Hemmings has for the past eight years been one of the two Foundation Governors at St Peter's School, and she has now decided to retire. During her time, she has been the Chairman of the Governors, and she has frequently gone into the school to help with preparation for SIAMS and R.E. St Peter's Church and the Diocese would like to thank Barbara for all her hard work and dedication she has put into being a Governor.
