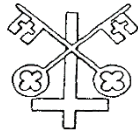

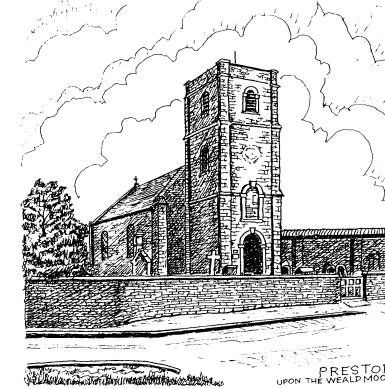
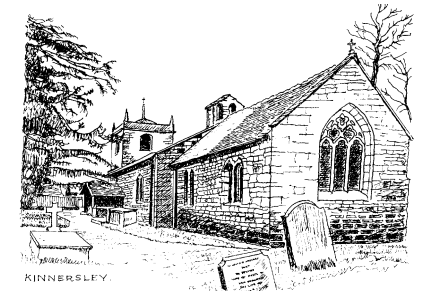

- This Evening -- There will be a Benefice Service of Reflection for Candlemas at St. Michael's, Waters Upton at 4.30pm.** This will include readings, music and silence. Please come and join us as we worship together as the six parishes on this special day.



- 3 **Our Organist Colin Brown** - after over 40 years of faithful and dedicated service it is with great sadness that Colin will be standing down as organist and choirmaster. Colin's last service with us will be on Sunday 7th April.
- 4 **Resident Minister Vacancy.** Thank you to all who helped to welcome the candidate on Tuesday and attended the service on Wednesday morning. Unfortunately, we have not been able to make an appointment at this time and the post will be re-advertised as soon as possible. Please continue to pray for this.
- 5 **Church Electoral Roll** - Don't forget this is the year when the entire Church Electoral Roll is renewed, so if you want to remain on the Roll you **MUST COMPLETE A NEW FORM.** Forms are available at the back of the Church and also from Jane Ryan, who is our Electoral Roll Officer. The completed forms can be put in the box at the back of the Church, or returned to Jane Ryan, or to the Rectory, until **10th March.**
- 6 **Thursday Holy Communion.** This service will now alternate between BCP on 1st and 3rd Thursdays and Common Worship on 2nd and 4th Thursday's. This is so that we have more balance between the forms of liturgy and have opportunity to use Common Worship more widely. The 7.45am Holy Communion on Sunday's will continue to be BCP.
