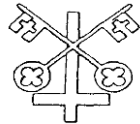

- 4 **Purple Cope** - The Rector is hoping to purchase a purple cope for use in Advent, Lent and at funerals. A parishioner has already given a donation and if anyone else wishes to give a donation please put it in an envelope clearly marked 'Purple Cope' and hand to either the Churchwardens, Treasurer or Rector. If you can "Gift Aid" your donation, then that will greatly help. (Gift Aid envelopes are available in Church.) The cope will cost about £500.
