

- 5 **This Saturday is Armistice Day, 11<sup>th</sup> November**, and there will be a short service at **10:50am** at the War Memorial by Manor Road, High Street. Everybody is welcome to come to this service.



- 6 **Remembrance Sunday** this year is next Sunday, 12<sup>th</sup> November. As usual there will be no 10:30am Sunday Eucharist that day. There will be, instead, the Remembrance Day Service at **10:50am**, when the names of all the Fallen from both World Wars and subsequent conflicts will be read out, wreathes will be laid in their memory and the community comes together to remember those killed in war.

- 7 **On Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> November at 7:00pm** in St Peter's Church, Edgmond there will be a concert by the **Beaumaris Singers**. Ticket price is yet to be confirmed and will be available to be purchased on the door. There will be refreshments and a raffle. Further details will be available later. - 8 **St Peter's Church Christmas Tree Festival** takes place on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> to Monday 4<sup>th</sup> December. Opening Times are as follows - Friday, Saturday and Monday 11:00am to 4:00pm.
