

# NOTICES

1 On Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> July Edward our Rector announced that he has advised the Bishop that after 26 years in the parishes it is time for him and Jane to retire. He will not be moving far away but Church rules say they must no longer live in the Parish. We will be sad to see them go in early Autumn, and he and Jane will be greatly missed. We thank them both for the great contribution they have made to our parishes over so many years and we assure them of our prayers and very best wishes for their retirement.

2 Sunday, 30<sup>th</sup> July is a fifth Sunday and the 10:30am service will be a Gathered Service of Holy Communion for the Six Parishes at St John the Baptist, Bolas Magna. There is no 10:30am service that morning at Edgmond.



3 Friends of St Peter's Church - The Friends of St Peter's was set up to assist St Peter's to fulfil its duty of worship and to contribute to the repair, maintenance, improvement of, and additions to the fabric, furnishings; and also to promote and support any charitable activities calculated to preserve and beautify the Church, its history and its magic. You may recall that it has organised several concerts and held a St Peter's Week festival in the church. We now need to appoint a new chairperson to replace Dr Julia Brown, who has moved to France, and also a new secretary to replace Mrs Stephanie Egleston. The work is not too demanding, and the positions are open to anyone in the parish; you do not have to be a churchgoer, just someone who would like to help support St Peter's Church. If anyone is willing to take on either of these roles please speak to the Rector or Churchwardens.

4 During the month of August, due to people's unknown holiday arrangements, the coffee rota does not 'name' anyone for making coffee, but purely relies on members of the congregation who attend the 10:30am service to 'volunteer'. If you have not made coffee before the only item we ask you to provide is the milk - all coffee, tea and squash is provided.
